- Club has two (2) new service projects during the administrative year
- Club continues a long term service project for a minimum of three years
- Club contributes to the District Foundation or KI Foundation of at least \$100
- Club President and Secretary attend KI Club Leadership Education (CLE)
- New members receive KI new member orientation
- Club has during current admin year an officer or committee member at a level above the club level.
